MIGRANTS WELCOME !

For years now, men, women and children have been fleeing wars, dictatorships and extreme poverty. When they arrive here in France, they are confronted by the inhumanity and indignity of wretched camps. In Calais, Grande-Synthe, Ventimiglia and in Paris at La Chapelle, Eole, Austerlitz, Jaurès, Stalingrad, a long list that clearly illustrates this non-welcome. If not intentional, it is obviously accomodating. By these means, politicians and authorities are hoping to discourage migrants from seeking asylum and thus from being able to live in dignity.

Words speak all too clearly when authorities decide "the unbearable has been reached". They don't plan to welcome, they EVACUATE ! Thus, on the 4th of November at 5 am, a massive police operation was planned to evacuate 3850 people who had been surviving in undignified, improvised street camps in the heart of Paris. Leading up to this were violent police raids, arrests, administrative detention and the issuing of OQTFs (an order to leave the French territory) that began in July.

If considered by some as an initial salutary shelter, the humanitarian camp on boulevard Ney is by no means a solution! Access restricted or denied without explanation, classifying and sorting of refugees, excessive presence of police, etc.

The means and legal structures exist, e.g., CADA, the accommodation centres for asylum seekers. These need to be permitted as mandated to house and assist refugees. Enough of the CHU Migrants (Emergency Housing Centres), the CAO (Reception and orientation centre), the CAD Minors, the PRAHDA (Dublin III, deportation risk), etc. etc.

Enough of this !

The rights of migrants have to be respected without recourse to discriminatory "special" or "specific" procedures that lead to racist and xenophobic maniplations.
